## SUPERINTENDENT'S CORNER

I always get excited this time of the year as we put some of those long hot summer days behind us and look forward to shorter cooler days. As we head towards the start of fall the golf course staff looks forward to many new challenges and changes in our day to day operations. Many steps are taken to prep the golf courses for winter play. Overseeding, changing in irrigation programming, fertilizing and fall spraying of pre-emergent herbicides are just a few things we do as we ready the courses for winter play. This winter we will overseed our Reserve Course fairways and tees. All par 3 tee boxes at Hollow Creek will also get overseeded. The seed was put down October 15<sup>th</sup>. With some help from mother nature and a good agronomic program we should experience good winter play conditions again this year.

Two other areas of focus for us this winter will be controlling cart traffic in dormant areas and cutting and moving of hole locations. Once again this winter we will be maintaining dormant ultra dwarf greens. In order to maintain color we will paint the greens if necessary to maintain aesthetics. This process proves very beneficial to the turf, promoting a much healthier year round plant. While dormant grass has proven to be an excellent putting surface we must remember that while dormant the turf is not actively growing and is slow to recover from stress. Ball marks, cup cutting and freezing and thawing cycles are all things that are hard on dormant greens.

This winter you can expect to see the hole locations change on an average of 3 to 4 times per week. During the summer we change them 5 to 6 times per week. Weather and amount of play will be the main driving factor in how often and when they are changed. We will also be cutting some holes in areas where cups have been cut previously. This will keep us from having numerous old plugs throughout the greens that have a slow time healing during colder weather. We will maintain 3 to 4 cupping areas in each area of the green and cut new locations monthly. This will help maintain the aesthetics, health and smoothness of the putting surfaces. You can help us also by fixing your ballmark and any other unfixed marks as soon as noticed. It takes no time at all to fix a ball mark or two and will prove helpful in the long term condition of our greens.
