attire, gym/work-out clothing,, swim suits/cover-ups.*

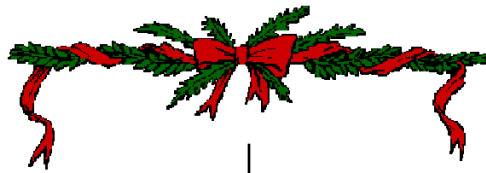

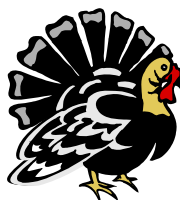

"TOYS FOR TOTS"

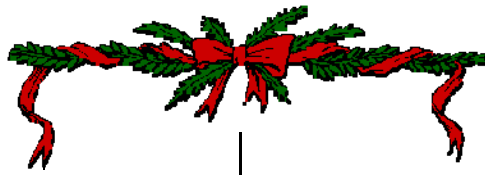

Hello Members,

I would like to take this opportunity to first thank all of you for welcoming me to The Reserve Club. It has been great meeting some of you while out on the course. I have enjoyed my short time here so far and am looking forward to the times ahead.

Secondly, this is a time of year when we get a lot of questions about home lawns. Many people assume that since the lawn goes dormant that there is no need to do anything else until the spring. This is far from correct and I would like to share with you just a few tips for things you can do during this time of year.

1. Fertilize. The most common misconception during this time of the year is “I don’t need to fertilize my lawn now because I just did it during the spring and summer”. In actuality you’re not feeding the lawn for above ground growth during the fall, you are feeding it so that it will store up nutrients and go into winter strong and will therefore green up faster when spring comes around.

2. Water. Next to not fertilizing, not watering is the second mistake that most home owners make the most during the fall and winter. Watering is very important during these months because many times there is not an adequate amount of rainfall. If the air temperature is above freezing and the soil isn’t frozen, you should try to water every 2-3 weeks for 15-20 minutes to provide water to the crown and roots of the plants.

3. Mowing Heights. Mowing at your current height should continue until the grass above the ground enters into dormancy. Once the grass has gone dormant, it no longer needs as much above ground growth. For the final mowing of the season, lower the cutting height to around 1 inch for warm season grasses. This will prevent the grass from laying over or matting down and will reduce the chance for disease.

Last but not least, be sure to remove your leaves on a regular basis. Waiting until all the leaves fall will leave a heavy, wet layer of leaves on your lawn that can smother the grass. The tips listed above are just a few of the key points that will help “winterize” your lawn and allow for a quicker green-up in the spring and healthier turf all growing season long.
