TO ALL OUR RESERVE CLUB FRIENDS

The Reserve Club AED Committee has helped develop this emergency plan for you to use in your house in case of an emergency. We believe that it is important for everyone to be prepared before an emergency takes place so that the response is proper, timely and effective. This plan acts as a guide for both the household members and emergency response workers. Please review it and fill in your information where appropriate. It is in your best interest to be aware of the nearest AED placement to your home. You should also find neighbors who would be willing to retrieve an AED in an emergency situation, no matter the hour. In return, be willing to do the same for them. Forms are available in the lobby and on pages 9 and 10 of the newsletter on the website. The committee recommends that members become comfortable with the use of AEDs and administering CPR. As of now, approximately 100 members have taken CPR/AED courses at the club and we will make more classes available according to demand.

GOLF COURSE NEWS & NOTES

Hello Members,

Finally, the winter woes are over, spring is here, and summer is right around the corner. Although, it would seem that summer is already here with all of the warmer than usual days we have had lately. As you may have noticed the flowers have not bloomed as early as they did last year, this is partially due to the bitter cold spells we had over the winter. With the cold finally behind us we are in the process of working on a number of projects to take us through the rest of the spring. I would like to recap the projects that were completed over the winter and discuss the up-and-coming projects for the next few months.

The winter season is our "project time", as you have probably observed us restoring bunkers and adding new drainage around the course. Here is an overview of some of the projects we completed this winter. Cooler than usual temperatures allowed us to spend more time working on projects and less time mowing, we were able to restore more bunkers this winter than in the past few winters. These bunkers included the second and third fairway bunkers on the left of hole seven, the big green side bunker at hole twelve, all three fairway bunkers on hole thirteen, the two fairway bunkers on hole sixteen and the second fairway bunker on hole seventeen. We added new sand to nine bunkers all together. We also performed many drainage projects, most of which were in high play areas. These projects included areas at the white tee on hole three, a spot in eight fairway and rough, area at front of hole eleven green in the complex, the right of hole twelve green in the complex, and in the fairway and rough before the fairway bunkers on hole thirteen. All of these projects were completed on the Nicklaus course. Both courses were also treated with a pre-emergent to help with winter and spring broadleaf and grassy weeds.

Since the start of spring we have aerified and fertilized some of our high cart traffic areas throughout both the courses helping to reduce soil compaction in these areas. Some of the upcoming projects we have planned include; bunker repairs, French drainage additions, landscape improvement in many areas and cart path repairs to numerous areas on The Reserve. Drainage projects we would like to complete on The Reserve include; right side of four fairway and on the slope, at the start of the fairway on hole seven, a couple of spots in sixteen fairway and the area at the green complex on hole seventeen. We also plan to continue adding additional landscape plantings to many areas of Hollow Creek including areas at the back of fifteen and fifth greens and throughout the seventeenth hole. We also have our greens aerification scheduled starting with the Hollow Creek greens the week of May 3rd with the Reserve greens starting the following week. I hope everyone is having a wonderful spring and enjoying the nice temperatures.
