# The Reserve Club Dress Code Policy

At the Reserve Club, we have adopted a dress code etiquette that adapts to today's more casual lifestyle and apparel trends, but is respectful to the expectations of a private club environment. In this spirit, fellow Members, guests, and associates must be mindful of their attire and abide by the dress code etiquette established to create a uniform benchmark for acceptable personal appearance while utilizing the various club facilities.

## **GOLF COURSE & PRACTICE FACILITIES:**

#### MEN: (Expectations)

- Golf slacks / Bermuda style or khakis shorts
- Golf shirts or other such tops available for purchase and widely marketed as golf apparel
  - With or without collars
  - Tucked unless designed to be worn out
- Hats with a brim to be worn with bill forward while outdoors

#### **WOMEN: (Expectations)**

- Golf slacks / Capri pants / Skirts / Bermuda style or khakis shorts
  - Stretch style golf pants with pockets
  - Leggings only if worn underneath skirts or shorts
- Golf shirts or other such tops available for purchase and widely marketed as golf apparel
  - $\circ$  With or without collars or sleeves
  - Tucked unless designed to be worn out
- Hats with a brim to be worn with bill forward while outdoors

#### PROHIBITED GOLF ATTIRE: (Men & Women)

- Gentlemen to remove hats while indoors
- Tee-shirts of any color designed as undergarments
- Tee-shirts with large printed graphics
- Tank, Tube, Halter, or Mid-drift tops
- Gym, athletic, jogging or cut-off shorts
- Swim apparel of any kind
- Tennis length skirts
- Denim of any kind or color

## **CLUBHOUSE FACILITY:**

#### STANDARD: (Men & Women)

- Casual attire that is properly fitted, free of rips, stains, excess wear, or fading
- Slacks, Denim, Bermuda style shorts
- Tennis attire permitted except in the ballroom area
- All shirts and tops should be tucked unless designed to be worn out

#### Clubhouse Etiquette / Prohibited Attire: (Men & Women)

- Gentlemen to remove hats while indoors
- All shirts to be tucked unless designed to be worn otherwise
- Tee-shirts of any color designed as undergarments
- Tee-shirts with large printed graphics
- Tank, Tube, Halter, or Mid-drift tops
- Gym, athletic, jogging or cut-off shorts
- Swim apparel of any kind
- Exposed undergarments
